Beak
The hard, hooked, pointed part that covers a penguin's mouth and helps it grab food

Coast
Where land meets water

Colony
A group of animals who live together

Equator
An imaginary line halfway between the North and South poles

Flipper
One of two flat, stiff body parts that stick out from the side of a penguin and are used by the animal for swimming

Marine mammals
Have fur and give birth to their young; unlike other mammals, they spend most of their time in the ocean

Porpoising
When penguins leap out of the water as they swim to move faster

Predator
An animal that eats other animals

Webbed
Connected by skin
